



## FLU VACCINE UPDATE

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Our office is expecting another shipment of seasonal flu vaccines in early November. The office will set up new flu clinic dates as soon as we have CONFIRMED delivery dates for our next shipments (this will avoid rescheduling and cancellations should shipments be delayed). You will receive an email alert as soon as we have any information regarding the shipments.

In an effort to help the families of our practice, our office staff has gathered some information regarding the current availability of the seasonal flu vaccine.

\*\*CVS in Riverside 1239 E. Putnam Ave. has flu clinics everyday for children 18 months old and older. Mon-Fri 8:30am - 7:30pm, Saturdays 9:00am - 5:30pm, Sundays 10:00am - 5:30pm. No appointment needed. At times there will be a break from 1:00-3:00 pm.

\*\*Stop n Shop Westport is having a flu clinic tomorrow, October 22, 2009 for children 11 years old and older. 3pm – 7pm.

\*\*Grade A Shippan is having a flu clinic tomorrow, October 22, 2009 for children 9 years and older (must be accompanied by a parent). 10am - 2pm. No appointment needed.

\*\*The Darien YMCA is having a flu clinic Saturday October 24th, 2009 for children 2 years old and older. 8am - Noon. No appointment needed.

\*\*The Darien Health Department is having a flu clinic on November 3, 2009 for children 4 years old and older. 4pm - 7pm. No appointment needed.

\*\*The Darien Immediate Care Center states you can walk in anytime for children who are 10 years old and older.

The Tully Center (of Stamford Hospital), all CVS's in Stamford, all Walgreens in Stamford, all Rite Aids in Stamford, Costco, CVS and Walgreens in Darien, New Canaan and Norwalk are all out of the vaccines. Some will possibly be getting more in November.

We will continue to keep you up to date with the latest vaccine developments as they arise.
